Overview:

Budtenders will assist the RMD Team Lead, Assistant Manager and Dispensary Manager with patient and customer intake processes as well as point of sale transaction input. The budtender will help to ensure that dispensary experience standards are met, and superb customer service skills are used consistently. This is a part-time position (20-30 hours per week), which could grow into full-time hours for the right person. Compensation is \$15/hour.

Key Duties and Responsibilities:

- Uses the Point of Service system to ensure all relevant information is recorded and tracked accurately.
- Maintain absolute confidentiality at all times.
- Ensuring standards of quality, customer service and health and safety are met.
- Responding to customer complaints and comments by following the proper chain of command.
- Updating the RMD Team Lead on business performance, new initiatives and other pertinent issues.
- Interacting with customers and identifying and assist in resolving urgent issues.
- Completion of orders and patient intake procedures.
- Assistance with product packaging, inventory management, inventory security, and cash security.
